### Typical Questions...

#### • What is CIA?

Catholics In Action is a 2-3 day service-learning experience for teams of high school youth and adults. CIA is offered to meet the immediate needs within our local community by providing service to others while giving teens the chance to encounter and process an experience of "doing" the mission of Christ.

#### • Who can participate?

Teens currently in grades 9-12, along with their parish adult leaders. **There must be 1 adult per every 5 youth participants who stays with the group.**

#### • When will the experience take place?

June 17-19, St. Patrick, Cedar Falls (home site) Contact: Jenny Hulme, St. Mary, Waverly 319-352-2493. Teens will be notified by confirmation letter of arrival/departure times for each session.

#### • What does the program cost include?

The program fee, \$20/person, will include program resources, lodging and meals for the event, journal, work supplies, and recreational activities. It will also include transportation to/from the work sites.

#### • Where will young people stay and work while participating in the program?

"Home site" for the teens will be St. Patrick Church, Cedar Falls, but teens may also stay on the grounds of other archdiocesan facilities. Work sites, sponsored by church and social service Agencies, may include working with children and families in need, in homeless shelters and soup kitchens, summer recreation and tutoring programs, painting and minor repairs to family homes and agencies. Jobs and sites are selected with safety in mind.

#### • What will team members do when they're not involved in their service work?

Back at the "home site", participants take part in a mix of recreational, educational and prayer activities. Structured group activities are planned each evening. The evening event is both an educational as well as a community-building experience, providing youth with the chance to grow together.

#### • Who sponsors CIA?
